

CASE FOR CAREGIVER BOOT CAMPS Caregiving is one of the toughest jobs you will ever love. Research has shown that caregivers often experience:

- Burdened, stress, guilt, loss income
- Painful and isolated environments
- Unprepared to be caregiver
- Poor self-care
- Good intentions often disintegrate into a tough, tense situation

**16.1 Million** American's provide <u>unpaid care</u> for people with Alzheimer's or other dementia's, an estimated 18.4 Billion hours of <u>unpaid care</u>.

According to survey findings, **64**% of participants indicated that the person affected with dementia related disease lives in the home with their caregiver.

**Every 65 seconds** someone in the United States develops Alzheimer's disease.

As baby boomers are reaching age 65, it is projected that by 2050, 83 Million people will be age 65 or over.

**I in 9** people over the age of 65 will be diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease.
